## CTE Career and Technical Education

### Get a job, get paid *and* get credit with the State of Wisconsin Youth Apprenticeship Program

- Open to high school juniors or seniors
- Learn industry-developed skill standards
- Gain exposure to multiple aspects of industry
- Work with skilled mentors
- Receive classroom-related instruction
- Get a state-issued skill certificate upon completion

#### LEVEL 1 (ONE YEAR) PROGRAM

*Open to Juniors and Seniors*

- Two courses of classroom instruction within student's Academy/Concentration.
- Completion of competency checklist.
- Minimum of 450 hours of paid, work-based learning (about 15 hours/week).

#### LEVEL 2 (TWO-YEAR) PROGRAM

*Open to Juniors only*

- Four courses of classroom instruction within student's Academy/Concentration.
- Completion of competency checklist.
- Minimum of 900 hours of paid, work-based learning (about 15 hours/week + summer work between junior and senior year).

#### Requirements:

- Minimum 2.0 GPA and good attendance record.
- Successful completion of coursework related to Youth Apprenticeship area.
- Recommendation from at least one related instructor or counselor.
- Career exploration, other guidance or education in choosing career area.
- Ability to demonstrate and attain required skills for Skill Standard Checklists.
